A WOMAN'S JOURNEY

Promise Land



So sultry, so hypnotic. The French singer Clotilde Rullaud floored some of us back in 2011 with her multifaceted

album In Extremis. Her latest project, a pared-back sequence of duets with the pianist Alexandre Saada, is every bit as intriguing. A homage of sorts to the art of the protest song, the repertoire shifts and swerves from Nina Simone to Marvin Gaye, not to mention Nicolette's No Government. Rullaud's voice, sometimes dark, sometimes girlish, floats above minimalist accompaniment that straddles the jazz and classical realms. **CD**
